## Virtual Schoolhouse Supplemental Education Service Policy

### **I. Steps in choosing students**

Student to be served:

- Low-income families
- With priority given to low achieving students
- Approved state tests (OAT/OGT/ Scantron) scores will be used to determine low achievement levels

Student limit is based on amount allotted by school per year

School will prioritize by grade level if student interest goes above allotted funds

At the beginning of each applicable school year eligible parents will be notified about the availability of provider services (using letter outline on ODE website) in an understandable format with the ODE link to all approved providers

Upon request, school will assist parents in selecting of an approved provider

Fair and equitable procedures will be applied to the selection process.

Privacy of selected students will be ensured

Agreements will be developed with state approved providers chosen by eligible families

### **II. Agreements**

Specific goals each student should reach

How to measure progress

Timetable for improving achievements which will be consistent with IEP (when applicable)

Providing regular progress reports to parents and teachers

How agreement will be terminated if goals aren't met

How often services will be provided

### **III. Evaluation Procedures**

Consult with chosen SES providers

Turn in effectiveness report to ODE
